2016 Vintage Notes

An early bud break followed by warm weather and spring rains brought a rapid start to this year's near perfect growing season in the valley. The fruit enjoyed beautiful weather during bud break and plenty of time to hang on the vines. Although yields were down due to drought, the berries were nice and plump, which resulted in a balanced and complex flavor profile.

2016 Field Blend Napa Valley

Field Blends are single-vineyard wines whose grapes are grown, harvested, and vinified together. We source our Field Blend from a rare, single vineyard in the Carneros appellation where different varietals are planted alongside each other. Our unique blend is predominately Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, with a touch of Petite Sirah and other old world varietals. This is a juicy, fruit-forward wine that's bursting with blueberry, plum, and cassis. Easy drinking and perfect for lunch, its delicate tannins make for a lush finish. We let our Field Blend age four years in bottle to create the perfect wine for people who love a succulent red blend for picnics. This is a food friendly wine, pair it with salads, lunch pasta salads, vegetarian dishes or chicken and salmon off the grill.
